Bring a Bag!!!!

Lunchbags

Please can you ensure that children lunch bags are wiped after every use to stop the building of crumbs and odours. This can be done using soapy water or anti bacterial spray and a cloth. The majority of lunch bags can be put in the washing machine on a gentle cycle and hung unzipped to dry.



Numicon



Parents **are encouraged not** to stay with children while they register themselves on the board or find their numicon, there is a member of staff in that area to aid them should they need it.



Colder Weather

We spend time outside every session no matter what the weather, so please ensure your child has a warm coat and waterproof outdoor shoes preferably **wellies** and a **hat** and **gloves** in preschool with them every day.

Footwear

Shoes should fasten with Velcro or similar **NO LACES** as we actively encourage children to change their own shoes, promoting independence and self care.



Labelling



Could you please ensure that **ALL** your childrens clothing and bags are labelled with their name, this includes coats and shoes. It doesn't have to be their full name, initials are fine.



Nut Free Preschool

We have a strict **NO NUT** policy at pre-school. This is to protect children with nut allergies. This includes **peanut butter** and **Nutella**. Please check cereal bars for nuts.



Please provide healthy balanced lunch boxes for your children. Fizzy drinks, sweets or anything chocolate covered are **NOT** allowed at preschool.

We aim to have a photo of all families in this album. The album is kept in the book corner and the children regularly look at it and enjoy finding their peers and their families. This photo can also be used for comfort if your child becomes upset.



Pull Ups

If your child is not potty training then proper nappies should be used, **NOT** Pull Ups. Pull ups often leak as they are only designed for minor accidents, we would be grateful if you could send your child with nappies rather than Pull Ups
