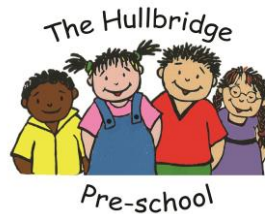

Maintaining children's safety and security on premises

Policy statement

We maintain the highest possible security of our premises to ensure that each child is safely cared for during their time with us.

Procedures

Children's personal safety

- We ensure all employed staff have been checked for criminal records by an enhanced disclosure from the Criminal Records Bureau.
- Adults do not normally supervise children on their own.
- All children are supervised by adults at all times.
- Whenever children are on the premises at least two adults are present.
- We carry out risk assessment to ensure children are not made vulnerable within any part of our premises, nor by any activity.

Security

- Staff are placed at the main door entrance for the safe arrival and departure of children this also prevents children from leaving our premises unnoticed.
- The arrival of child and staff at preschool is marked in daily register and departure of child from preschool is marked in register by collecting adult.
- The arrival volunteers and visitors is recorded in the visitors book.
- The main gate to the preschool locked during session times to prevent unauthorised access to our premises.
- The personal possessions of staff and volunteers are securely stored in store cupboard during sessions.
